An invitation to participate in creation of the HAIKU ZBORNIK - LUDBREG 2021

The Editorial Board and the Center for Culture and Information Ludbreg (Centar za kulturu i informiranje Ludbreg) invites all interested haikuists who want to participate in the creation of the *Haiku zbornik - Ludbreg 2021* to send their haiku.

The number of haiku that can be submitted is limited to **6 per author**. For those who practice to write erotic haiku, at least one haiku can be (in those 6) with that theme. The best erotic haiku will be awarded with the “Afrodita” plaque.

The haiku for publication in the *Haiku zbornik - Ludbreg 2021* will be selected by the editorial board.

Please send the haiku in a Word document (as an email attachment) which you will name by your last and first name (e.g. johnson.john.docx). Please do not send documents that have the name like HaikuLudbreg2020.docx or similar.

If the haiku are translated into English (preferably!), be sure to write the name and surname of the author of the translation.

Please do not sign the haiku with any codes, but only with the author’s name, surname and the country it comes from.

An invitation to participate in creation of the *Haiku zbornik - Ludbreg 2021* has no competitive character.

Deadline for submission

You can submit your haiku until **April 30, 2021** (for postal items, the date of the postmark is valid). Haiku received after this deadline will not be included in the *Haiku zbornik - Ludbreg 2021*.
